General Description:

DoIT would like to reclassify our Graphics Designer position, a position previously funded by SSFAB, to a Database Administrator position. This position is more aligned with the needs of the division. Graphics design work has decreased in the last few years due to the creation of multiple Communications Specialist positions within the Division. Database administration is a critical need for Division IT.

Request Type: Full Increase One-Time Partial/Matching

How does this increase impact students, and what motivated this request (needs, strategic planning, etc.)?

The acquisition of a Database Administrator will allow DoIT to provide better service to all Division departments who use databases. Graphic Design work that was previously done by this employee has been taken up by the various departments. DoIT saw the need in 2007 to fill this function for the Division, but the intervening years have seen a reduction in demand. The Database Administrator position has a higher salary than the Graphics Designer position due to the nature of the work. DoIT will provide the funds to make up the difference.
