General Description:			

Current intern salary is \$26,420/year. While this used to be in the top 10% of intern salaries nationally, it is now closer to the middle. To help attract outstanding interns to College Station, I am requesting an increase in their base salary. This will not put us back into the top 10%, but we will be much closer. Our pre-doctoral interns have completed everything for their doctorates except dissertation and the internship itself.

Attracting top candidates to our internship equates to better services to our students as well as more energy and new ideas for the Department. This request was also triggered by the fact that the SCS will no longer be able to pay the University portion of health insurance for interns for the first three months of employment.
